### 6. Action Items

a. Election of Officers: The SSTAC discussed nominations and voted to fill the Chair and Vice-Chair positions.

Motion was made (Ratnam/Gallagher) to elect Richard Johnson as Chair and Saskia Rymer-Burnett as Vice Chair. Motion passed unanimously.

**b. SSTAC Membership Appointments and Terminations:** The SSTAC appointed two new members and terminated two members.

**Motion was made** (Ratnam/Merkel) to recommend the HCAOG Board make the following appointments to the SSTAC: Peggy Martinez as the representative of potential transit users with a disability and Carol Moné as a public representative for the Coalition for Responsible Transportation Priorities and to authorize the Chair to write a Notice of Termination to the HCAOG Board recommending the Board take action to terminate Gavin Smiley and to terminate the seat for the Blue Lake Rancheria Transit System from the SSTAC. **Motion passed unanimously.** 

c. Revised SSTAC Bylaws: The SSTAC discussed revisions to the SSTAC bylaws. Motion was made (Ratnam/Pratt) to recommend the HCAOG Board approve revisions to the SSTAC Bylaws with additional edits to clarify that no more than 50% of meetings in a calendar year can be missed and that section 4.03 does not apply to the nine statutorily required members.

Motion passed unanimously.

d. FY 2024-25 Unmet Transit Needs (UTN) Comments and Reasonable to Meet Recommendations: The SSTAC reviewed comments, survey results, and the draft FY 23-24 UTN Report of Findings.

Motion was made (Ratnam/Johnson) to direct staff to update the UTN comments matrix and proceed in preparing the FY 24-25 Report of Findings based on which needs are reasonable or not reasonable and to bring the report back to the SSTAC at the May meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Public transit is now available from Crescent City to Santa Rosa using tap and pay cards. RTS has returned to pre-COVID hours (earlier in the morning and later at night).
