2. Public Participation on Non-Agenda Items

3. Approval of Meeting Record

4. Action Items

a. FY 2025-26 Unmet Transit Needs (UTN) Report of Findings

The SSTAC reviewed the final FY 2025-26 UTN Report of Findings.

Motion was made (Pratt/P.Martinez) to recommend that the HCAOG Board adopt the FY 2025-26 Unmet Transit Needs Report of Findings determining that there are unmet transit needs that are reasonable to meet but cannot be funded.

Motion passed unanimously.

b. Transit Needs: Humboldt County's Roads/911 Emergency Response Measure O

The SSTAC discussed what entities should be eligible for receiving transit funds from Measure O. Discussion took place regarding the ability to reassess eligibility in the future. **Motion was made** (P.Martinez/Cleverton) to recommend that the HCAOG Board consider approving Measure O Tax Funds be made available to transit agencies that meet the same eligibility requirements as Transportation Development Act State Transit Assistance Funds and provide transit services to the general public.

Motion passed unanimously.

5. HCAOG Executive Director Report

Interim Executive Director Debbie Egger announced that the new Executive Director, Brendan Byrd, will begin his work with HCAOG on April 28th. Discussion took place regarding upcoming meetings. The regular May meeting will be cancelled and a special meeting may be called prior to the next regular meeting in August if there is a need to take action on any Measure O tasks.

6. SSTAC Member Reports

Peggy Martinez announced that May is Bike Month and that the Bay Trail Grand Opening will take place on June 28th.
