#### **Staff's Recommended Action:**

1. Introduce the item as an action item;

5. Discuss item and consider making the motion:

“I move that the TAC recommend the HCAOG Board approve the 2026 Bicycle and Pedestrian 2% allocation requests as discussed by the TAC.”

#### **Staff Summary:**

Pursuant to HCAOG's adopted Rules and Regulations for the Administration of the Transportation Development Act, 2% of the available Transportation Development Act (TDA) Local Transportation Funds (LTF) is set aside for the exclusive use of projects aiding bicyclists and pedestrians.

50% of the yearly allocation is reserved in a set-aside fund intended for use if at any time an urgent regional priority projects come up. A total of \$101,870.15 plus interest of \$16,616.33 was received in 2025. After reserving 50% into the set aside fund, the available allocation for this year is \$59,243.24. The balance of the reserve is \$649,879.86. Previously the reserve amount was set for \$500,000, however, based on recent discussion with the TAC there will be a future revision to the HCAOG TDA Rules that will increase the reserve amount to \$1,000,000.

Two TDA claimants requested funds this year. The total funding request is \$29,774 which is under the available allocation. The funding request is summarized below, and the full request is included with this staff report:
