5. Consent Calendar

Motion was made (Kenny/Madrone) to approve the following consent items:

- b. Adopt Resolution 26-18 approving the City of Ferndale's FY 2026-27 Local Transportation Fund claim in the amount of \$46,202.63.
- c. Adopt Resolution 26-19 approving the City of Fortuna's FY 2026-27 Local Transportation Fund claim in the amount of \$414,084.85.
- d. Adopt Resolution 26-20 approving the City of Rio Dell's FY 2026-27 Local Transportation Fund claim in the amount of \$131,801.96.

8. HCAOG Staff and Board/PAC Member Reports

a. HCAOG Executive Director's Report

- Interim Executive Director Debbie Egger discussed being back in the office and the 101 corridor project.

b. Caltrans Report

- Indianola Interchange Project: The median crossing closures at Mid-City Motors, the site of the old mill, Bracut, and Bayside Cutoff will start next week. The construction of the northbound traffic signal at Airport Road is underway and should go live at the end of July or early August. All construction activities should be wrapped up by the end of the summer.
- Eureka Slough Bridge Project: Piling driving has started on the repair of the existing bridge and is estimated to continue through October of this year.
- Fourth and Fifth Street Corridor Feasibility Study: The study will look at safety operations and integration of bike, pedestrian, and transit. It is expected to be completed by the end of the fiscal year.
- Hilfiker Traffic Signal: Expected to go live at the end of August.
- US 101 Corridor Management Plan: The draft US 101 Corridor Management Plan is still open for public comment.

c. Board/PAC Member Reports

- PAC Member Arroyo discussed upcoming grant funded capital improvement projects including the Eureka Intermodal Transit Station groundbreaking in August and pavement and capacity improvements at W Street this summer.

4. Presentations

a. Last Chance Grade Project

Caltrans Project Manager Lianna Winkler-Prins presented updates on the Last Chance Grade Project.
