2. Adjournment of the HCAOG Board; Convening of the Policy Advisory Committee (PAC)

The PAC convened to include representatives from Caltrans and Humboldt Transit Authority.

3. Public Comment on Non-Agenda Items – None

4. Presentation

a. Humboldt Transit Authority Measure O

PAC Member Arroyo shared information on the spending plan for Measure O funds that Humboldt Transit Authority will receive.

7. Action Items

a. Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3, Bicycle and Pedestrian 2% Allocation – City of Blue Lake Project Modification Request

Motion was made (Atkins-Salazar/Wilson) to recommend that the HCAOG Board approve a modification to the 2024 2% TDA funding request from the City of Blue Lake. **Motion was approved unanimously.**

b. Consultant Selection for Partnering Assets and Authorities for Comprehensive Transit (PAACT) Planning Project

Motion was made (Wilson/Bergel) to recommend that the HCAOG Board award a professional services contract to DKS for the Comprehensive Plan for Regional Transit and Land-Use Network Planning project.
