7. Action Items

a. 2023-2028 Five-Year Humboldt County Transit Development Plan (TDP) (encl)

Representatives from LSC Transportation Consultants, Inc presented the final 2023-2028 Five-Year TDP.

Motion was made (Jones/Atkins-Salazar) to adopt the 2023-2028 Humboldt County Transit Development Plan with the possibility of amending the plan to include transit solutions for the City of Blue Lake.

9. Reconvening of the HCAOG Board

10. HCAOG Staff and Board/PAC Member Reports

a. HCAOG Executive Director's Report

Executive Director Burks provided the following information:

- HCAOG was awarded a REAP 2.0 grant in collaboration with HTA and We Are UP for microtransit and housing development in McKinleyville.
- On October 28th there is a housing exhibition at Jefferson Community Center where works from artists supported by the REAP 1.0 grant will be displayed.
- The TAC will be voting on and prioritizing projects for the current STIP cycle at their next meeting. The list will then be brought to the board at the next board meeting.
- There will be a presentation on the Caltrans Road Charge Committee updates at the next board meeting.

b. Caltrans Report

Caltrans representative Tatiana Ahlstrand provided the following information:

- The Arcata 101 Merge Project is currently under construction. Will be completed in the spring.
- Fernbridge construction is almost complete. Caltrans is looking into a seismic notification system and safety protocols in the event of another earthquake.
- Last Chance Grade is now open to two-way traffic for the first time in nine years. An environmental document for the long-term solution for Last Chance Grade will be out this winter. Construction on that could begin as early as 2030.
- The FY 2024-25 call for applications for the Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant opened on October 5th and applications are due by January 18th.

c. Board/PAC Member Reports

Pac Member Arroyo discussed Humboldt Transit Authority stepping in to provide transit for the Blue Lake area. Their tap on/tap off card system has been successful. The Transit App is a useful tool for transit both in our area and across the country.
