The Board conducted a public hearing and received comments pursuant to Sections 99238.5 and 99401.5 of the Transportation Development Act. Associate Regional Planner Stevie Luther gave a presentation on the state of regional transit. The following individuals provided comments on unmet transit needs:

Colin Fiske – In order to provide more frequent service, later service, earlier service, and service seven days a week, we need more investment in the transit system. It is admirable to create standards to prioritize limited funding, but if other transportation systems, such as roads, were held to such standards most would fail.

Latanya Jacob – Times of service in the Eureka area should be increased to seven days a week. Routes and frequency should increase.
