9. Reconvening of the HCAOG Board

10. HCAOG Staff and Board/PAC Member Reports

a. HCAOG Executive Director's Report

- The new callboxes on Highways 36 and 96 are currently being installed and coming online.
- HCAOG's office had a break-in over the weekend. One laptop and at least one file were taken.
- Beth will be out of the country until March 4th. Senior Regional Planner Oona Smith will serve as Acting Director until she returns.

b. Caltrans Report

- Tatiana Ahlstrand provided updates on the following:
 - There was an information Draft Environmental Document public open house regarding Last Chance Grade on January 24th. Review of the document continues. The final draft and selection of preferred alternative will take place between April and June of this year.
 - There will be a full 40-hour closure of Fernbridge on February 23rd. There will be a stakeholder engagement meeting tentatively on March 11th.
 - Caltrans met with community members of Orick to discuss community-led visions for improvements in the community.
 - New staff members in District 1 include Jerome Washington the District Native American Liaison and Megan Brunner, Public Engagement Coordinator. Upcoming positions to be filled include a hydrologist focused on sea level rise and a transit planner.
 - FY 2024-25 Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant applications have been received including one submission from HCAOG. Announcements will take place in June 2024.

c. Board/PAC Member Reports

- Councilmember Atkins-Salazar recently attended a CALCOG meeting and provided updates on the topics which included housing, housing trust funds, public education on the gas tax, and electrification and hydrogenation of rural areas.
