


#### Sex of children for parents that provided information


















Parents' opinions about how much their child's school encourages or discourages walking and biking to/from school

1588150	My children are too young in my opinion to walk/bike alone. As they get older, and I feel as though the routes are safe, I will consider. Crossing guards would be awesome.
1588163	I'm a very protective father and would not allow it until at least 10-12 years old with another or group of them.
1588181	I do not allow my child to walk or ride to school by herself until she gets into 3rd or 4th grade.
1588226	Parents park in the red zone in front of the school with no backlash from the school. Also no crossing guards are offered for kids to cross the street safely.
1588171	Lack of sidewalks is a concern in this area - especially since the conditions of roads are very poor.
1588208	My child walks or ride's bike home when a family member or myself come down to accompany him. Too many adults to encounter on his way home that are inappropriate.
