Staff Summary:

On July 23, 2024, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors voted to place Humboldt County's Roads/911 Emergency Response Measure on your Nov. 5, 2024, ballot. In November, over 63% of voters supported authorizing an additional sales tax of 1% with revenue dedicated to road infrastructure improvements.

The ballot measure was to maintain 911 response times and prepare for natural disasters by:

- ❖ Repairing deteriorating county roads/bridges
- ❖ Fixing potholes
- ❖ Maintaining evacuation routes
- ❖ Improving transit services
- ❖ Becoming eligible for Humboldt County's fair share of state/federal roads funding

Humboldt County Public Works Director Tom Mattson will provide a presentation to the TAC, seeking input and suggestions on road project selections and spending plan from the portion of Measure O Sales Tax Revenue that is dedicated for county road improvements.

The Humboldt County Board of Supervisors will receive funding recommendations for roads and transit from the Funding Workgroup at their April 14th meeting.
